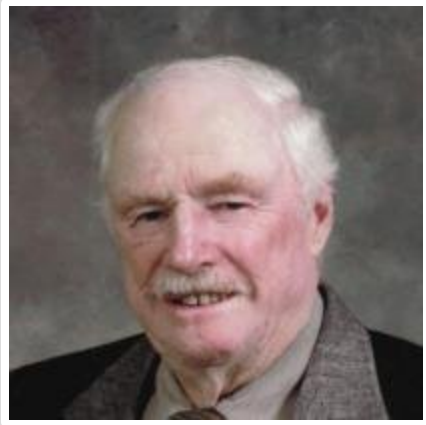




Albert Hein
