He ended his working career in Fort Saskatchewan with Smith Insurance Services Ltd.

Frank is known in the community for his love of hitting the road in his motorhome, smooth moves on the dance floor, quick wit, impeccable dress and DJ services. He was a regular feature at the local nursing home, extended care facility and other seniors' facilities as well as at retirement parties and anniversaries into his late eighties when a back injury made moving his heavy sound system too difficult.
