



Herman Theodor Haukenfrers

May 29, 1928 - May 9, 2014

It is with much sadness in our hearts and a huge realization of loss in our lives that we have said goodbye to our husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother and uncle, Herman Theodor Haukenfrers. He went to be with his Lord and Saviour on the morning of May 9, 2014 at the age of 85.

Herman was born in Oldenburg, Germany on Tuesday, May 29, 1928 to Hermann and Johanne Haukenfrers. He was one of seven brothers and three sisters and all but one sister immigrated to Canada. He loved having his family within driving distance.

He moved to Edmonton in 1952 and was employed at CanWest Seed (later called United Grain Growers) until his retirement in 1988. He has been an active member of Central Baptist Church since 1952, although from 1960-69 he was a founding member of Salem Baptist Church.
