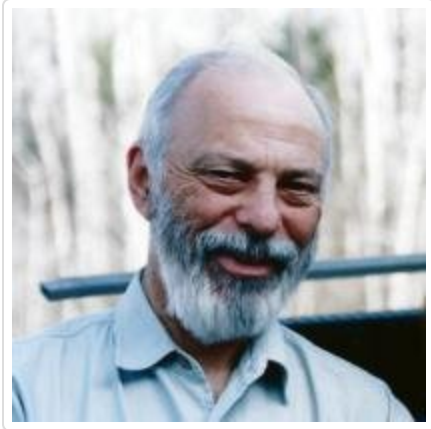




James Maurice Dooe Hlady
