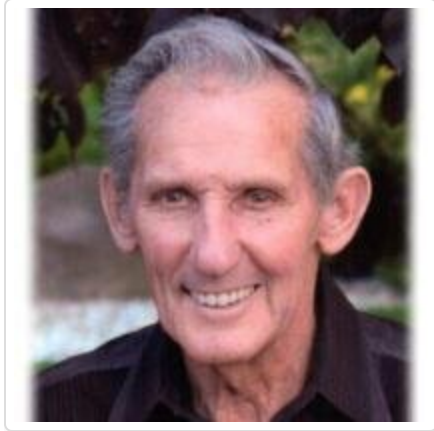




John (Pete) Lamoureux
