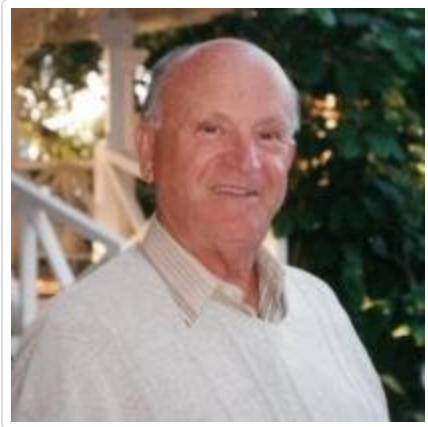

John was dedicated to his family. He gave his time and insight whenever needed with commitment and passion. John enjoyed the holidays in Maui with family and friends. The many happy times shared at the Wizard Lake cottage and farm were also high on his list. He also enjoyed nothing more than

hunting with his pointers and boys.
