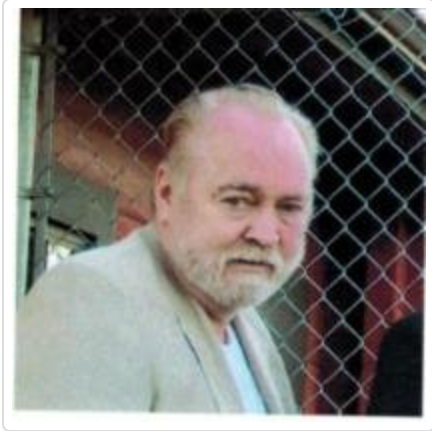




Mr Joseph Frederick Meyers
