On Sunday, May 11, 2014, Larry Polachuk of Spruce Grove, Alberta, passed away suddenly at the age of 73 years. Larry is survived by his loving wife Hope; son Kevin (Nicole), step-daughter Heather (Craig), step-son Stephen, mother Mary Fedorovich, and numerous other relatives and friends.
