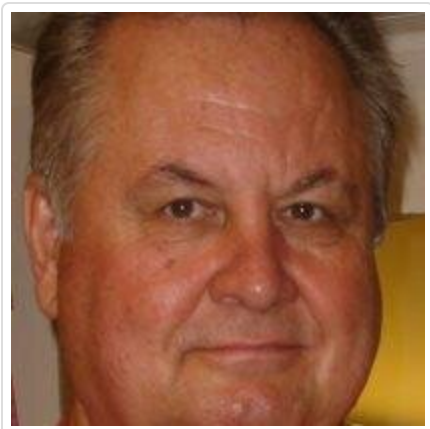




Mr. Lawrence John Polansky
