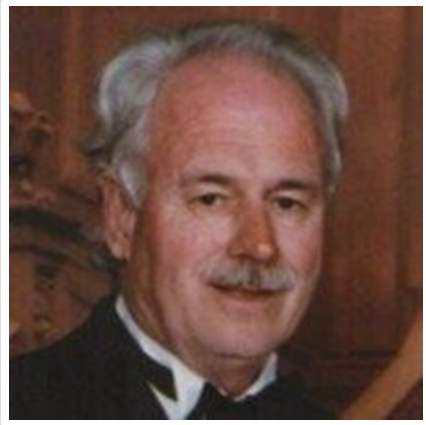




Leroy Nolan Chapman
