In heavy hearts we announce the passing of Mary in the early hours of March 6, 2015. At 95 years of age, Mary still had a mischievous sense of humour and a curiosity about life around her. Mary enjoyed having visitors, friends and family to spice up her days.

She was born on the farm in Barich, Alberta on February 14, 1920 to Thomas Yasinski and Anna (Chersick) Yasinski. Mary had two children, both of whom have predeceased her: Lawrence (Larry) Polachuk (May 11, 2014) and Billy Joe Polachuk (8 days old). She was happiest when she was busy. whether in the garden, kitchen or at work, she always had a smile on her face. 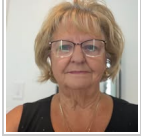
