June 7, 1945 - July 18, 2013

It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Monika Parlow on July 18, 2013 in Leduc, Alberta, at the age of 68, due to Alzheimer's disease. She was born Monika Irmgard Heiselbetz on June 7, 1945, in Schnellin, Germany, the only child of Irmgard and Guenther Heiselbetz.
