



## Robert Victor D'Eath

It is with great sadness and heavy hearts we say good-bye to a sweet, caring and kind man. Robert Victor D'Eath, 88 years of age, passed away on Thursday, June 11, 2015. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather.

Bob was born March 25, 1927 in Calgary, AB. He was the first born son of Christian Victor and Dorothy Lily joining his sister Christina and then to follow his brother Peter and younger sister Pamela. Bob attended Crescent Heights High School and in the summer months played football and could often be found diving into the Bow River off of the Louise Bridge. In 1962 Bob accepted a position with the Alberta Motor Association and along with his wife and two children transferred to Edmonton, AB. Bob moved back to Calgary in 1995, and several years later returned to Edmonton where he met and married his second wife and loving companion Margaret Dorene Kristensen. The last 11 years with Dorene were filled with fun, laughter and love. Bob's greatest pride and joy were his children, four grandchildren and three great grandchildren. Right up until he became ill he never missed a school concert, sporting event or dance recital.
