It is with great sadness and love we announce the sudden passing of Susan Kehler on February 26, 2014 in Edmonton, Alberta. Susan was born in Blackpool, England on March 05th, 1934. She immigrated to Canada in 1951 and lived in Carmen, Manitoba, where she met her husband Art Kelher. Following their marriage they moved to Edmonton, Alberta in 1953.
